Completed size: 20 1/2cm x 12 1/2cm (8" x 5")

Requirements:

- 15cm (6") cream linen
- 25cm (10") yellow and white floral stripe
- 25cm (10") blue and yellow hexagon
- 10cm (4") green and white stripe
- 5cm (2") red and pink stripe
- 25cm (10") iron on interfacing (Vilene H410)
- 10cm (4") square of template plastic

COSMO embroidery threads:

- 163 light blue
- 166 dark blue
- 328 dark green
- 631 light green
- 800 bright red

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Let's get started!

- Be sure to read all the instructions before starting your project.
- Pieced seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam allowance.
- Transfer the design to your fabric using a light box and super fine Pigma pen.
- You will find a stitch and thread guide enclosed, hand stitching is completed with two strands of threads unless otherwise noted.

Cutting requirements

Linen fabric cut:

- One 5" square.

Blue and yellow hexagon fabric cut:

- One 8½" x 14½" rectangle.

Red and pink stripe fabric cut:

- One 1" x width of fabric.

Cotton wadding cut:

- One 10" x 16" rectangle.

Yellow and white floral stripe fabric cut:

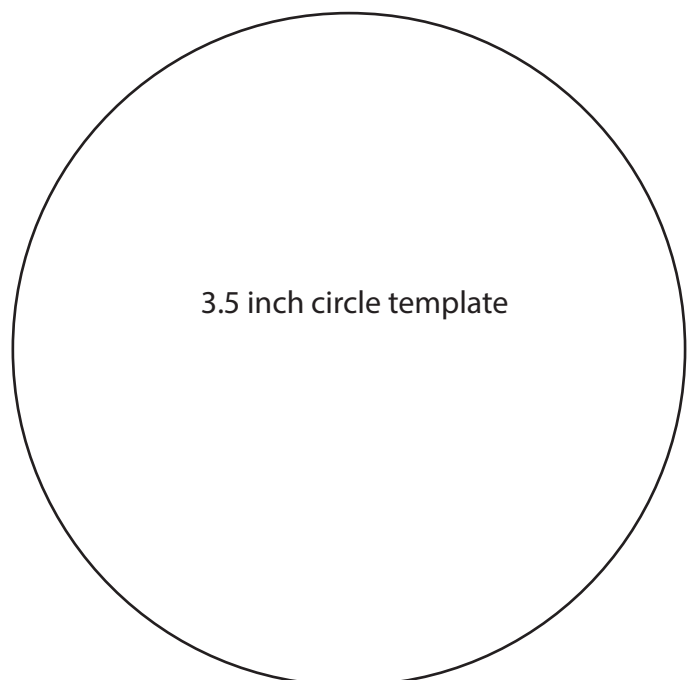
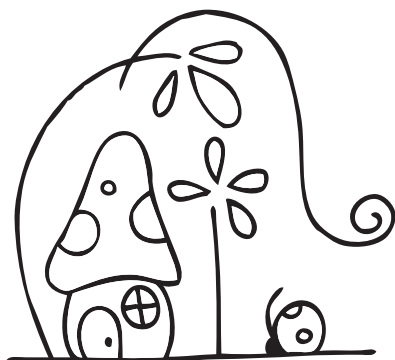
- One 10" x 16" rectangle.

Green and white stripe fabric cut:

- One 2" x 17" strip.

Iron on interfacing (Vilene H410) cut:

- One 5" square.



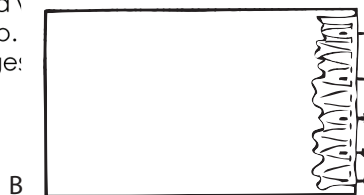
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Making your flip pouch

- Centre and transfer the mushroom stitchery design onto the right side of the cream 5" square. Fuse 5" square of iron on interfacing (Vilene H410) to the back to help stabilize the fabric before embroidering.
- Place your stitchery fabric into an embroidery hoop or frame to tension the fabric and complete the embroidery referring to the thread guide and stitch diagrams enclosed.
- Using a pen or pencil, trace template circle (A) onto template plastic and cut the circle out along the drawn line.
- Centre the 3½" circle template over the completed mushroom stitchery and trace around the template using a wash away marker or super fine Zig pen. Cut out the fabric circle allowing a ¼" seam allowance and place aside.
- Take the 10" x 16" (yellow and white floral stripe) rectangle and place together with 10" x 16" cotton wadding, baste to hold. Machine quilt across the width of the fabric in ¼" increments. Once complete trim the quilted block to measure 8½" x 14½".
- To make the ruffle trim, take the 2" x 17" (green and white stripe) strip and with right sides together fold in half along the length making one folded 1" x 17" strip. Sew along both 1" seam, clip the corners and turn the folded strip right side out, press lightly.



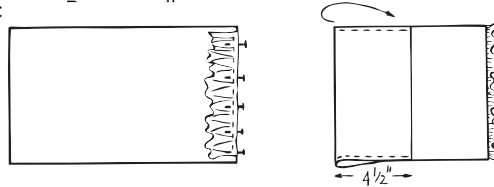
- Take the 8½" x 14½" (yellow and white floral stripe) rectangle and place on a flat surface with right side facing up. Sew the ruffle trim along the 14½" side of the rectangle. Match raw edge: the rectangle. Match raw edge:



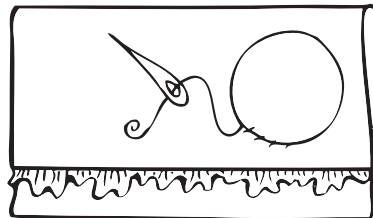
- Place the 8½" x 14½" (blue and yellow hexagon) rectangle over the quilted/ruffle panel matching raw edges. Sew both panels together leaving a 5" opening along the 14½" side seam.
- Clip all corners and turn right side out through the 5" opening. Carefully push out all corners and press well. Slip stitch the 5" opening closed and top stitch around the edge with a ¼" seam allowance.

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- Place the panel on a flat surface with the ruffle facing toward the right and lining fabric (blue and yellow hexagon) facing up. Refer to **Diagram C** and measure 4½" from the left seam, fold the panel at this point. Pin and slip stitch the side seams together, fold the right side over the left to close the glasses case.



- Take the round embroidery design and position over the right side of the glasses case, use appliqué pins to hold fabric in place while you begin needle turn appliqué. Refer to **Diagram D** for placement.



- Using sharp scissors snip around the edge of the circle from the raw edge toward the pen line, turn the raw edge under with the tip of your needle and appliqué in place. Take care to appliqué on to the top layer of fabric not through to the lining fabric.
- Take the red and pink stripe 1" x width of fabric strip, remove the selvage edges and fold both short ends over ¼" and press. Fold the strip in half along the length with right sides facing out, press. Open the strip and fold both raw edges in again toward the centre fold line, press.
- Top stitch both sides of the folded strip using a ½" seam allowance to complete the tie. Wrap the around the Mush-roomie Flip pouch and tie in a bow to finish.

Stitch & colour guide

Description	Thread	Stitch type
Toadstool	321	back stitch
Toadstool spots, door and window	321	back stitch
Ladybird body and antenna	321 – one strand	back stitch
Ladybird head and door knob	321	satın stitch
Flower stems and curls	471	back stitch
Flower petal (outline)	517	back stitch
Flower petal (solid)	800	satın stitch
Grass	904	back stitch
