



Embroidered hoop that's Purrrfect for cat lovers.
Completed size - 4" hoop diameter

Requirements

10" square white linen.
10" square light weight iron on interfacing (Vilene H410).
4" bamboo embroidery hoop for finished product only.
Embroidery hoop or frame (optional).

COSMO embroidery threads:

1000 cream.
2702 yellow.
120 dark green.
118 medium green.
155 charcoal.

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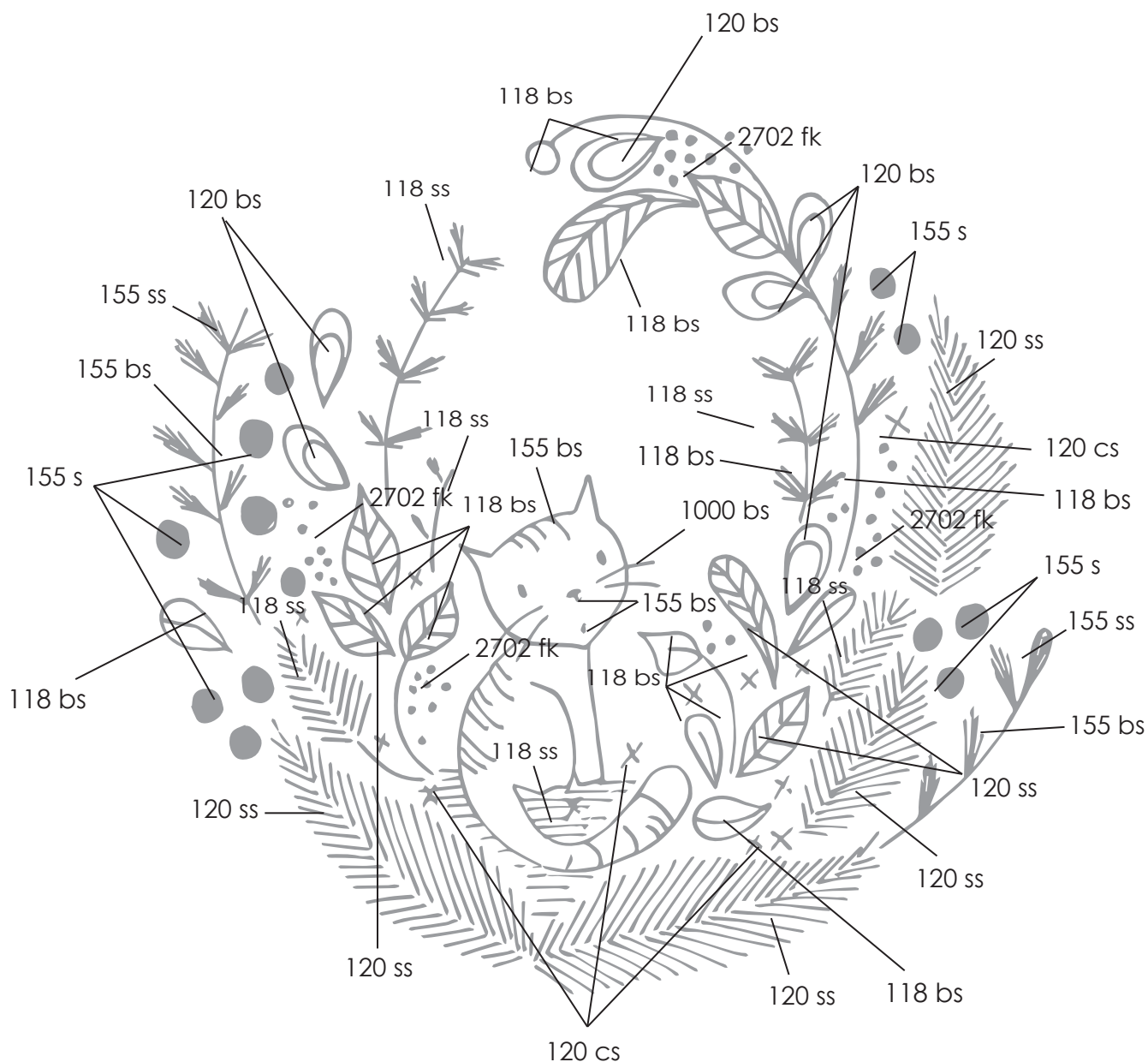

ss - straight stitch | cs - cross stitch | bs - back stitch
fk - french knot | s - satin stitch

All large solid spots	155	ss
All small spots	2702	fk
Leaves	refer to above diagram	
Grass under cat	118	ss / single strand only
Cat whiskers	1000	bs / single strand only
Cat stripes	155	bs / single strand only
Cat's mouth & eyes	155	ss / single strand only



Tracing the design to fabric

Using a light box and super fine Pigma pen or wash away marker, hand trace the embroidery design on Page 3 to the middle of your linen square.

Using interfacing and stitching hoops/frames

Fuse light weight interfacing to the back of the linen and if you wish place your fabric into a medium sized stitching frame to help tension your fabric, this will prevent any lumps and bumps in your final piece.

You can hand stitch without a hoop or frame so the decision is yours. If you are not a hoop convert yet I think you would love the finish of your work if you tried!

Thread and stitch selection

The pattern will assist you with thread selection and stitching. Use the pattern cover image in combination with the thread selection diagram and stitch selection on Page 2 to help select threads and stitch types required.

All stitches are completed with two strands of thread unless noted in stitch guide.

If you want to change it up and add your own touch that would BE AWESOME TOO!

Hooping it up & finishing

Once you have completed your embroidery place into the 4 inch bamboo hoop and tighten the screw hold firmly. Trim the excess fabric allowing a 1/2inch seam.

Fold the 1/2inch excess fabric into the back side and glue onto the hoop lip creating a neat finish for hanging.

I enjoy seeing the 'messy side' of my stitching work so I don't cover it up. If you wish to hide the messy side just cut a circle from card and glue in place.
